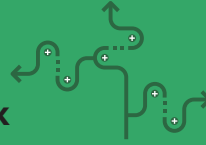

STATUS UPDATES

- Last comprehensive bike report was released late Spring 2020, showcasing 2019 data.
- While counted bike volumes dropped substantially in 2020 and 2021 due to COVID, counted bike volumes in 2022 are the highest since 2019.

TOTAL BIKES COUNTED

2020: 5.33 million
2021: 4.70 million



BIKEWAY NETWORK IMPROVEMENTS

463.7 total miles; 121 protected miles
2020: 15.3 new & upgraded miles
2021: 17.7 new & upgraded miles

BIKE PARKING

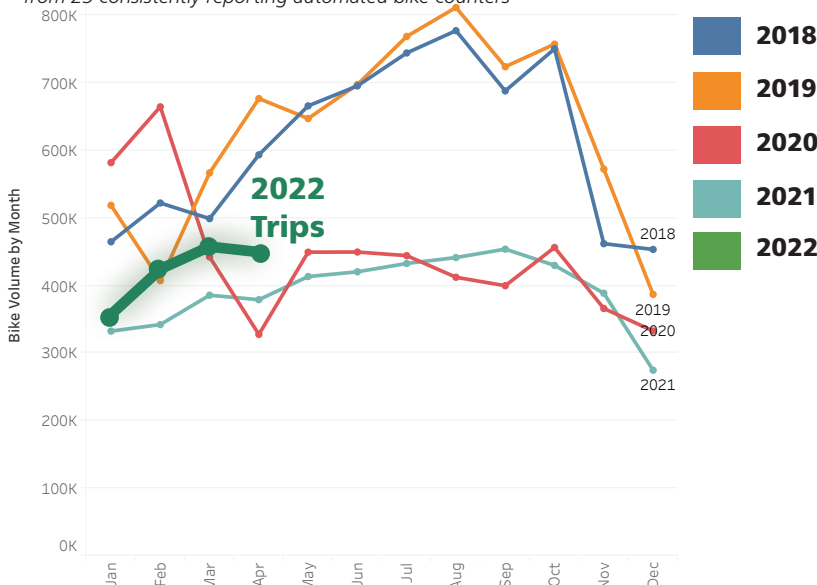
2020: 1,024 new racks;
2,048 new parking spots
2021: 660 new racks;
1,320 new parking spots

Pre-pandemic: 328 racks installed per year.

2021: 1.74 million

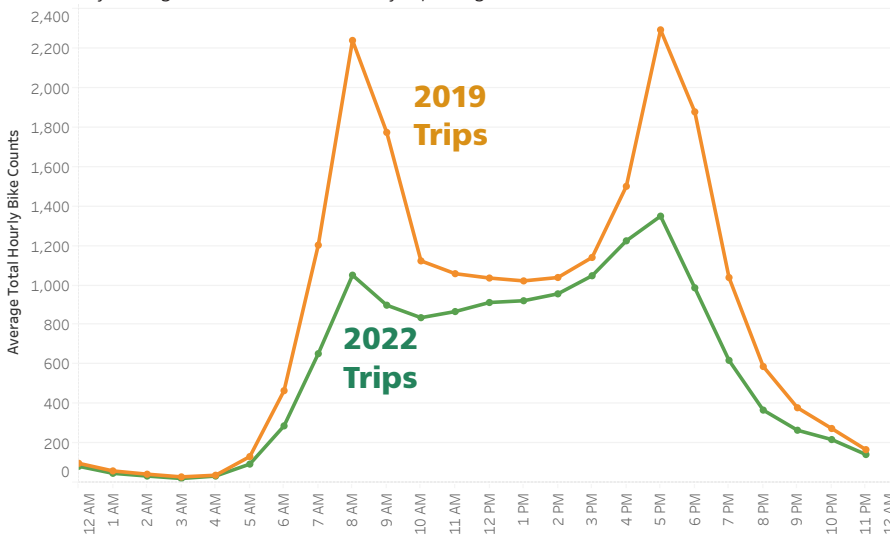
AVERAGE BIKES AVAILABLE (11am-3pm)
